Welcome to the Millbrook Mardi Gras Festival
Located in Village Green Park Across from 3160 Main Street Millbrook, Alabama, 36054.
Please help us take care of our park!!

It is your responsibility to review and adhere to all the following information. Failure to do so may result in your being denied space.

1. See the Vendor Assignment document for your Space Number(s).
2. PLEASE REPLY TO THIS EMAIL to CONFIRM RECEIPT.
3. Spaces are marked in large **NUMBERS** on the ground. When driving in the park, please be very careful not to run over any of the sprinkler heads. They are marked with red flags. Also, Please do not run over our low-profile electrical outlets throughout in the park. They are covered with plastic tubs or marked with elevated reflectors. The cost of repairing these outlets is very costly.

All tents, trailers, tables, etc., are to be set at least ONE FOOT off Paved Walking Trail to allow Emergency vehicle passage! Also, Paved trail is used by Vendors to get to their space(s).

(All Traffic for Spaces 11-71 and C Section will flow best if Park is ENTERED at South East corner of Park and EXITED at North East corner drive. ONE WAY traffic around Path.)

The following space directions are given facing the park from Main Street.
NORTH is to your right, WEST is looking toward back of Park, SOUTH is to your left and EAST is behind you (toward Main Street).

- Spaces 0-72 begin with space 0 to the left of the second lamp post from the Flagpole, and then continue around the inside of the path first north, then west, then south, then east, around the path, then north back to the left of the stage.
- Spaces 1-10 & 69-72 are on the front facing the street.
- Spaces B0 - B13 are on the outside of the path in the northeast corner of the park.
- Space B0 is across the path from space 3.
- Spaces C1-C7 are on the outside of the path on the north side of the park.
- Space C1 is across from space 20.
- Spaces D1-D13 are inside (not on the perimeter) of the park. Vendors assigned to these spaces have been or will be shown their space.

4. Your number on the ground is the CENTER OF YOUR SPACE. Face any way you wish to maximize your exposure. It is always good to face both towards the path and towards the inside of the park if possible.

Suggestions are as follows:

- Spaces 1-72: Vend from both directions, if possible, except as noted below.
- Spaces 41 thru 49: will probably be best facing the path. Use your best judgment.
- Spaces 50 thru 65: should definitely face both towards the path and towards the inside of the park. If this is not possible, use your best judgment and perhaps more toward the inside of the park.
- Spaces 66 thru 72 : should probably face the path.
- Spaces in areas B and C: should face the path.

Most vendors set up Saturday beginning around 7:00 a.m.

IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT YOUR SETUP FIT COMPLETELY, (SIDE TO SIDE), WITHIN YOUR SPACE. THIS INCLUDES THE TRAILERS TONGUE.

Craft Spaces are 12' by 12', Food Spaces are 14' by 12'. You may use additional space, if available, in the front or rear of your space but you must not setup anything on that additional space until after 7:30 A.M. on day of Festival.

It is strongly suggested that trailers setup on Friday, afternoon before Festival, to avoid potential problems.

YOU ABSOLUTELY MUST NOT SET UP WITHIN SEVEN (7) FEET OF ANOTHER VENDOR'S NUMBER ON THE GROUND. IF YOU DO, YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO MOVE AND RISK BEING PERMANENTLY BANNED FROM OUR FESTIVAL.

5. You may set up on Friday afternoon or evening, at your own risk, if you wish. If you set up on Friday, you may stay with your setup overnight if you wish. WE DO NOT PROVIDE SECURITY. However, the police station is a about 1000 feet away and police have been notified that vendors will be in the park and will patrol it as much as possible.
6. Vehicles not used for vending must be removed by 8:45 a.m. Saturday. There is limited parking across the path on the south side of the park. Additional parking may be had across the creek in the large parking lots. A walking bridge is at both ends of the park. Some vendors whose spaces are on the back (west) side of the park have found that it is easier for them to park across the creek and then transport supplies across the walking bridges.
7. If you have trouble finding your space, call my number at bottom of page any time before 10:00 p.m. Friday or after 7:00 a.m. Saturday. I will be in the park by 7:00 a.m. on Saturday to assist vendors.
8. **ELECTRICITY USERS NOTE:** Electric plugs are only one 20 amp. outlet with two plug-ins. Each vendor is restricted to plugging in only one wire per electric space rented! Power strips are allowed but you must not exceed 20 amps. Personal generators for additional power are allowed. An electrician will be onsite for problems. If a problem is determined to be your fault, the electrician will charge you for services. Also, bring extension cord(s) in case of any power issue.
9. Food vendors are REQUIRED to have hand washing facilities and/or wear gloves when handling food. This is a Health Department requirement! The Health Department has been given food vendors information.
